

Implement the Franklin Park Action Plan NOW!

The City spent nearly a million dollars and more than three years developing the Franklin Park Action Plan. FPC worked hard to ensure that input came from park users representing every neighborhood around the park. We all participated in community meetings, completed surveys, and offered comments. Action Plan implementation must begin NOW.

The Plan, endorsed by the Mayor and city officials, calls for about \$1.2 million in the City's operating budget for maintenance and management and a \$20 million capital investment *annually* over the next decade to reverse the trend of disinvestment in our park.

Additional project management staff to support capital projects	3 new staff citywide, but not dedicated to Franklin Park
